Curriculum Vitae

Born in Rome on 7 December 1962.

In July 1987, he graduated cum laude from the University of Rome, La Sapienza, with a degree in Law.

From September 1987 until December 1988 obligatory military service as Second Lieutenant in L'Aquila (Acqui Brigade, Logistic Battalion).

In March 1991 he entered the diplomatic service and began his career at the Directorate General for Political Affairs at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, with a portfolio covering relations between Italy and Latin America.

From 1994 to 1998 he was Deputy Head of Mission at the Embassy of Italy in La Paz, Bolivia. He then moved to Montevideo, Uruguay, where he also was Deputy Head of Mission at the Italian Embassy from 1998 to 2002.

In 2002 he returned to the Ministry in Rome serving as Head of the Office of the Directorate General for Italians Abroad and Migration Policies covering the issues related to immigration, international adoptions, refugees and international protection.

In 2005 he moved to the Embassy of Italy in Tokyo, Japan, where first he was working as Political and Press Counsellor and then as Head of the Economic Section.

In 2009 back to the Ministry in Rome, he was in charge of the Office of the Directorate General for Europe dealing with a wide range of issues related to the European Union integration process, such as, among others, energy, environment, transport, economy and finance, agriculture, industry and internal market.

From 2012 to 2016 he was Consul General in Geneva, Switzerland, and from 2016 to 2020 Ambassador of Italy in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, covering also Tajikistan.

In 2013 he was bestowed with the title of "Ufficiale" of the Order of Merit of the Italian Republic

In 2017 he was promoted to the rank of Minister Plenipotentiary.

Back again to Rome in 2020, he was serving as Inspector at the General Inspectorate of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, visiting every year many Italian Embassies, Consulates and Cultural Centers throughout the world.

In February 2026 he was appointed Consul General of Italy in Toronto.

Married, three son and one step-son.

He speaks English, French, Spanish and has an elementary knowledge of Russian.
